




Friends of Hazlemere C of E School OGM 28th January 2021 (via RingCentral)

<p>5. First Aid</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Mrs Bhabra has asked whether The Friends would be prepared to fund a First Aid course for the children as it is a curriculum requirement. An online course proposed for year 5 initially, at a cost of £12 per student (approx. £360 per year group). Was generally agreed that face-to-face training would be preferable but should this not be possible due to current circumstances, the online training would be revisited. The Friends have previously funded First Aid course for both KS1 and KS2 students at a cost of £1,000. The Friends would be happy on a long-term basis to fund First Aid training for the whole school every 2 years at a cost of approx. £1,000.
