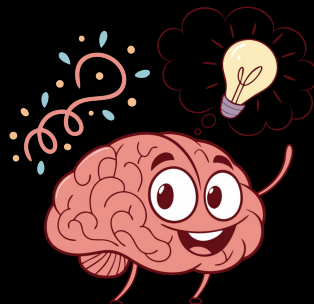
COME ALONG TO OUR QUIZ
